Baseball – Phil Uher

- Rules Review
 - Mustang & Bronco pitching rules changed to be in line with Little League rules
 - 21 - 30 pitches 1 calendar day of rest, 31 - 40 pitches 2 calendar days of rest - passed
 - 12 & Under must play 50% of their in-house games prior to tournament teams being announced in order to be eligible - passed
 - 14 & Under must play 50% of their regular season games to be eligible to participate in in-house playoffs - passed
 - Pony
 - continuous batting order and free substitution - passed
 - Federation Players can optionally play inhouse. If that option is chosen then the current rules regarding attendance are in effect - passed
 - lets us conform with other associations that we are playing with due to lower numbers
 - If North Hills Federation begins to enforce boundaries there will be a 1 year (2012) exemption on the requirement that for player to be eligible for the Fed teams
